I will be writing about the racism and police control that is going on right now in 2020. If some of you are not watching the news or you're not hearing about what is going on with the world right now, then you might as well find a comfortable place to sit and to read about what I am going to tell you, so I hope you enjoy.

As most of you know we have the corona virus going around the world and hospitals, policemen, laboratory workers etc. are trying their best to keep everyone as safe as possible with the limiting, 6-feet apart, wearing mask, keeping everything sanitary rules, but they started opening up places again once the govern had given all of the businesses a date that they could reopen. Once most of the places started to reopen, everyone was thrilled that they were able to go out again like normal human beings, when all of a sudden there was a rude awakening for the world a few days later. I am not sure what the weather was like in Minneapolis, Minnesota however a young, African American, Father and a husband was being arrested for a "fake \$20 bill", now you may be thinking "Why are they arresting him for a fake \$20 bill", or "Its not that big of a deal to have to arrest someone for a fake \$20 when they could go to a bank and get another \$20".

In this case, George Floyd could not go to a bank or reach in his wallet because he was in handcuffs, sitting on the ground, while resting his head on the police officer's car. So what did

the police officer do you may ask, well he threw down Mr. Floyd on the ground and put his knee on his neck for 9 minutes. Mr. Floyd was telling the one police officer that his neck hurts then he started to yell out to the other police officers that were there saying “I CAN’T BREATHE!!”, “YOU’RE ON MY NECK!!”, IT’S GETTING HARDER TO BREATH!!”, “MY STOMACH HURTS!!”, “MY BODY IS HURTING!!”, “PLEASE HELP ME!!”. Unfortunately, none of the police officers bothered to help out Mr. Floyd which caused him slow and a painful death while lying on the ground yelling, begging and pleading for help. The man who was charged with third-degree murder and second-degree manslaughter of George Floyd was Officer Derek Chauvin, Although the other police officers Tou Thao, Thomas Lane, and J. Alexander Kueng have not been charged with anything but will be under investigation to figure out what they’re going to do with them.

As you may have seen on the news/newspaper, social media or heard from a friend that there are protest and riots going on because of the death of George Floyd pinned down and suffocated to death in a hands of an officer(2020), Alton Sterling being shot at close range in the hands of two white police officers(2016), Ahmaud Arbery while taking a jog while being chased down by two older white males(2020), Walter Scott talking to the police officer in a respectful manner until he pulled out his gun on Walter while he was running to get help; he got shot(2015), Stephon Clark was shot in his own grandmothers backyard after the police officers had “mistaken” his cellphone as a gun(2016), Terence Crutcher was being cooperative with the officer while walking with his hand up in the air and was still shot to death(2016), Philando Castile was pulled over for a “broken tail light” when the police officer thought he was a part of a robbery because the man had a gun in his car which he had a permit for, the officer shot him twice at the heart; police officer was found not guilty in 2017, Eric Harris was mistaken for

having a .38 caliber stun gun(2015), and my final but gruesome Black male is Tamir Rice a 12-year boy, a little boy, being shot for HOLDING his BB gun outside a recreational center, the police officer did not hesitate to shoot the young boy. People of color are now in fear of going out of their house but they're going to stand up for what they had to watch or go through with all of these police officers killing the young and old people of color, no matter how many protests the people will have, no matter how many riots they create, this is unfortunately the last source they're going to use since the peaceful protest that they've done before are not enough. To the people that read through my entire 3-page paper congrats for actually taking the time out of your day just reading of how I feel about this whole situation expectational coming from a person of color and having family members and friends of color, I am frustrated that some people are not trying to listen on why colored people or even some people who are not of color are hurting because of this crisis going on. If you can spread awareness of what is happening, please make my essay paper the start of spreading your awareness. I am begging you to just listen and try to help the people who are hurting and suffering from this world, let them know that they're loved no matter what skin color they are, let them know that they can be just as good or even better than that one person, let the person know that their religion or beliefs doesn't change the way that you think about them, let them know that they're being heard from, tell them that you care about how they feel, it's like if someone was a rape victim help them that you will go through the rough patches with them, tell them it doesn't matter what they were wearing NO MEANS NO and please for the love of god to just tell them that you will do everything in your power to stand up for what is right and for what is wrong that is going on in this world, tell them that they're loved. Let the world know that there needs to be changes with this world and it needs to happen NOW, not next week not next year, it needs to happen NOW, the changes start with me whether

people are going to be with me or not. I am tired of sitting here watching my people go through the most miserable and painful life, it's not fair, and it's not right, my voice needs to be heard and it needs to be appreciated. I am tired of sitting on my couch watching my people go through life the way that they shouldn't go through, we deserve to be protected from racial things like the law enforcement, we shouldn't still be treated and talked to like slaves!! It is sad and frustrating that people are still treating and talking to us like slaves, just because you're in and law enforcement uniform doesn't mean that you should treat us any less of a person than you are, the fact that people use their uniform to gain that "power" and to have the right to beat on us like a punching bag is really upsetting and disappointing. We're supposed to be able to go the law enforcement about problems and now we can't even go to them because they take advantage of their uniforms. They need to change the system, they need to make the law enforcement a lot harder for the people that are going into the law enforcement, they need to make sure that they do real life situations and see how they truly are when they get out there on the field whether it's only them or they have a partner out there with them. Something needs to be done to not only protect my people and to make them feel safe but to make sure that the people in the law enforcement people know what they're doing and to make sure that they will not use their uniform as a way of getting out of situations while they're out there on the field. I want people to know that it doesn't affect older people it also affects the younger generation as well, but a it is a little harder due to how other kids are raised by their guardian(s). It's unfortunate that people still teach their children to be racist towards others and to make them feel like our color and our feelings didn't matter to the world. My voice deserves to be heard, I am tired of sitting here and hoping that they will help make changes into our world, if they don't do it then I will do whatever it takes to step up into that position to get the equality that we deserve.
